NOTICE

Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2071(e), the Clerk of the Court hereby gives notice of and an opportunity for comment regarding the Court's amendment to Eastern District of Tennessee Local Rule 83.10. Additions are underlined; deletions are struck through.

- (1) ~~The defendant shall not commit another federal, state, or local crime during the term of supervision;~~
- (21) The defendant shall not leave the judicial district or other specified geographic area without the permission of the Court or probation officer;
- (32) The defendant shall report to the probation officer in a manner and frequency directed by the Court or probation office;
- (43) The defendant shall answer truthfully all inquiries by the probation officer and follow the instructions of the probation officer;
- (54) The defendant shall support his/her dependents and meet other family responsibilities;
- (65) The defendant shall work regularly at a lawful occupation unless excused by the probation officer for schooling, training, or other acceptable reasons;
- (76) The defendant shall notify the probation officer ~~within 72 hours of~~ at least 10 days prior to any change in residence or employment;
- (87) The defendant shall refrain from excessive use of alcohol and shall not purchase, possess, use, distribute, or administer any narcotic or other controlled substance, or any paraphernalia related to such substances, except as prescribed by a physician;

- (98) The defendant shall not frequent places where controlled substances are illegally sold, used, distributed, or administered, or other places specified by the Court;
- (109) The defendant shall not associate with any persons engaged in criminal activity and shall not associate with any person convicted of a felony unless granted permission to do so by the probation officer;
- (110) The defendant shall permit a probation officer to visit at any time at home or elsewhere and shall permit confiscation of any contraband observed in plain view by the probation officer;
- (1211) The defendant shall notify the probation officer within 72 hours of being arrested or questioned by a law enforcement officer;
- (1312) The defendant shall not enter into any agreement to act as an informer or a special agent of a law enforcement agency without the permission of the Court;
- (1413) As directed by the probation officer, the defendant shall notify third parties of risks that may be occasioned by his/her criminal record or personal history of characteristics and shall permit the probation officer to make such notification and to confirm the defendant's compliance with such notification requirement.
