Sandy Garrett has served as Tennessee Board of Professional Responsibility Chief Disciplinary Counsel since 2012. Prior to this time, she was the senior litigation counsel for the Board and also served in various other roles. She is a graduate of the University of Tennessee and Vanderbilt University School of Law.

James Vick is the Deputy Chief Disciplinary Counsel—Investigation & Disciplinary Counsel for the Tennessee Board of Professional Responsibility. Mr. Vick graduated from Austin Peay State University in 1972 with a Bachelor of Arts and from the University of Louisville Law School in 1979. He was Assistant Commonwealth Attorney in Louisville, Kentucky, from 1980 to 1983 and practiced at the Nashville firm of Maddin, Miller and McCune from 1983 to 1996. Mr. Vick has been with the Board since 1996.

The TN Supreme Court Revises Rule 9

On August 30, 2013, the Tennessee Supreme Court filed comprehensive changes to Supreme Court Rule 9 governing attorney discipline. Changes to new Rule 9 address reinstatements; confidentiality; recusal; practice monitors; attorneys convicted of crimes; incapacitated attorneys; appointment of a receiver; appeals and attorney suspensions for default of student loans.

The effective date of the Court's new Rule 9 is January 1, 2014
