**STANDING ORDER**

Third-year law students enrolled in an ABA approved law school and certified by the Supreme Court of Tennessee to practice in the state courts pursuant to Rule 7, §10.03 of the Supreme Court of Tennessee, shall be admitted to practice in this court, under the supervision of an attorney admitted to practice in this court and employed by either the Office of the United States Attorney or the Office of Federal Defender Services of Eastern Tennessee, Inc. for the purpose of representing either the United States or individuals charged with federal offenses. As a precondition to appearing before the court, the student's name shall appear on a list certified to the Clerk of the Court by either the United States Attorney or the Federal Community Defender.
