## **STANDING ORDER**

Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 137, it is hereby ordered:

- The Chief Judge will enter reassignment orders for any cases to be reassigned to a visiting judge;
- 2. For criminal cases, upon entry of the Judgment in a case assigned to a visiting judge, the Clerk's Office will REASSIGN the case to the district judge originally assigned to the case pursuant to this Standing Order, unless otherwise ordered by the Court;
- 3. For criminal or civil cases, upon the expiration of a visiting judge's term, the Clerk's Office will REASSIGN any cases assigned to that visiting judge to the district judge originally assigned to the case pursuant to this Standing Order, unless otherwise ordered by the Court; and
- 4. If the district judge, who was originally assigned to a case, is unavailable for reassignment upon entry of the Judgment in a criminal case or upon the expiration of a visiting judge's term in a criminal or civil case due to retirement from active service, then the Chief Judge shall REASSIGN the case to another active district judge.
