<b>In Accordance with SO-21-19 The Following Visitors May Not Enter Any Courthouse in EDTN</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Has been advised to self-quarantine by any doctor, hospital, or health agency within the last 14 days</li> <li>2. Has been diagnosed with COVID-19 or told to presume they have COVID-19 by a health professional within the last 14 days</li> <li>3. Has had contact with anyone who has been diagnosed with COVID-19 or told to presume they have COVID-19 by a health professional - unless diagnosis was more than 14 days ago and the person diagnosed has been symptom-free for the past 72 hours or they are fully vaccinated</li> <li>4. Has had the following symptoms within last 14 days, not attributed to another known condition: cough, shortness of breath, fever of 100.4 or higher, chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, loss of taste or smell, or extreme fatigue</li> <li>5. 6. Has been released within the last 14 days from federal, state or local jail, prison or other correctional institution - except those reporting to be fitted with a location monitoring device or those under halfway house supervision.</li> </ol>					
<b>In Accordance to SO-21-19, All Visitors Entering Any Courthouse in EDTN Must Pass through Entry Screening</b>	<p>Entry Screening includes:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Pass through contactless temperature scanner. Any visitor with a temperature of 100.4 degrees or higher will not be permitted to enter the courthouse.</li> </ol> <p>In the Distict Court, Bankruptcy Court, and Probation and Pretrial Services Spaces:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. All visitors must wear a mask regardless of vaccination status.</li> </ol> <p>In all other areas of the courthouse:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. All visitors must wear a mask regardless of vaccination status when the county within which the courthouse is located is experiencing substantial or high community transmission of COVID-19 as defined by the CDC.</li> </ol> <p>When required to wear a mask by these rules, the mask must be made with at least two layers of breathable material that fully covers the nose and mouth, is secure under the chin, fits snugly but comfortably against side of face, and is secured with ties or ear loops. The following are not permitted: face shields, neck gaiters, open-chin triangle bandanas, face coverings containing valves, and mesh material or holes of any kind. Masks will be available for anyone not wearing a compliant mask.</p>
