STANDING ORDER

Effective immediately, the following procedure will be followed in the processing of CJA 20 vouchers in cases involving two or more defendants:

- (1) Vouchers that claim fees (exclusive of expenses) less than the statutory maximum will be processed immediately.
- (2) In the discretion of the Court, vouchers that claim fees (exclusive of expenses) over the statutory maximum may not be processed until every court-appointed attorney in the case has submitted his/her CJA 20 voucher.
- (3) Section 230.13 of Chapter 2 of the GUIDE TO JUDICIARY POLICY requires an attorney to file his/her voucher no later than forty-five (45) days after final disposition of the case. If the Clerk has not received an attorney's voucher within that time, the Clerk shall file a notice instructing that attorney to submit his/her voucher within seven (7) days. If no voucher is received within that time, the attorney's claim for fees and expenses shall be deemed WAIVED.
