STANDING ORDER

On November 1, 2014, the guideline amendment reducing by two levels the offense levels assigned to the quantities in sections 2D1.1 and 2D1.11 of the *United States Sentencing Commission Guidelines Manual*, designated as Amendment 782 in Appendix C, and made retroactive by Amendment 788 in Appendix C, became effective. The Court anticipates that a significant number of motions will be filed as a result of this guideline amendment. Accordingly, unless otherwise ordered in any specific case, for any motion seeking relief pursuant to Amendment 782, the Court **DIRECTS** the government to file a response and **EXTENDS** the deadline for responding such that the government shall file the response within forty-five (45) days of the filing of the motion or January 5, 2015, whichever is later.
